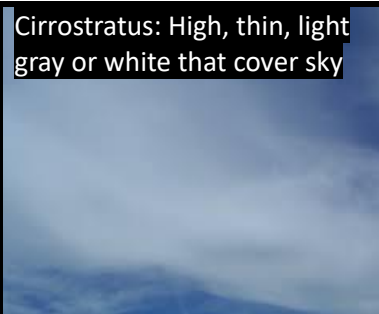


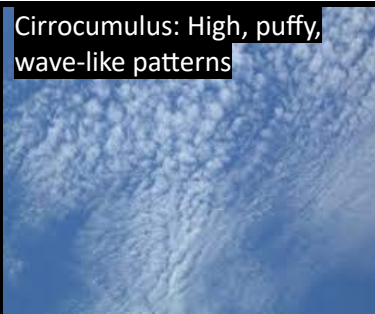
Cirrus: High, thin, wispy



Cirrostratus: High, thin, light gray or white that cover sky



Cirrocumulus: High, puffy, wave-like patterns



Contrails: High, formed by planes



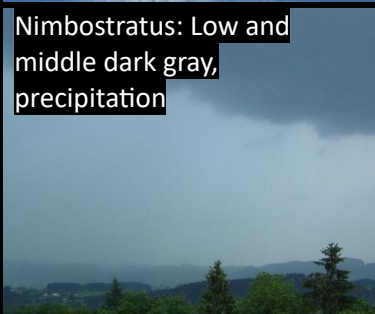
Altostratus: Mid level puffy



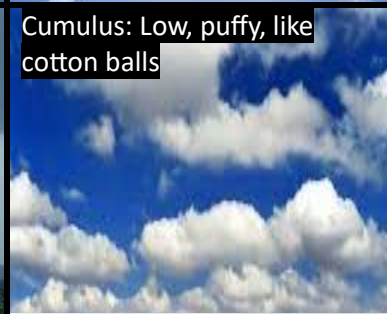
Altostratus: Mid level, light gray and uniform



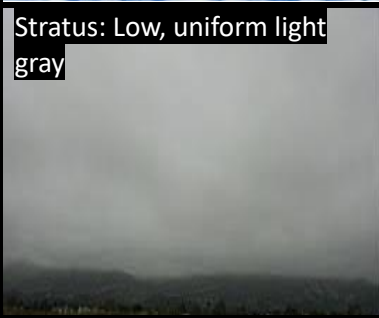
Nimbostratus: Low and middle dark gray, precipitation



Cumulus: Low, puffy, like cotton balls



Stratus: Low, uniform light gray



Stratocumulus: Low, rolling or puffy



Cumulonimbus: Low, large, dark base, anvil shape



Fog: Low, light gray with low visibility
